## ONBOARDS

Photographer Christopher Makos designs surfboards for the living room, not the beach. More for art than for folly, the waterproof boards are emblazoned with his prize-winning pictures. Calvin Klein went with one with shots of cars; his ex-wife, Kelly, selected horses, while Jane Holzer opted for photos of her old pal, Andy Warhol. Each shelled out \$15,000 for the handmade surfboards. Landlubbers got a glimpse of Makos' surfing safari at an exhibition at Gallerie Colette.

Inspiration struck when Makos was swimming with a friend in Miami Beach. "I am always trying to think of different venues to put my photographs on," he says.

This fall, Makos' focus will turn to horses, when Glitterati publishes *Equipose*, his 14th book. This is new territory for Makos, who is better known for his shots of Mick Jagger, Elizabeth Taylor, John Lennon and Warhol.
